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Observations

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#13 Look Out

This morning I must have got up from the wrong side of the bed. There's some hard feelings in my message today.

I woke up thinking about the Uintah Mountains, for some reason I have been drawn to them ever since my first visit to them when I was about twelve years old. It wasn't until this year that I think I have some idea of why.

The Uintah's are different Mountains, they are nothing like the Rockies, well named, as you will see. The Uintah's are still in their original layers. As you are coming over the pass at Bald Mountain, look at the make up of the layers. They, for the most part are still in the original position in which they were created.

Now look at the layers as you come down Parleys or Weber Canyon. You remember "Devils Slide" in Weber canyon, well there is something just like it, only smaller on the north side of Parleys as you've come over the summit into the Park City Valley area. I remember asking my dad as a child, "How did that rock wall get up there?" Well it is plain to see in both canyons that the layers are standing on end and no one can say they were created that way. The layers, for the most part were created parallel with the earth surface, and most likely created by the sediments settling in the bottom of a large body of water with billions of tons of weight pushing them into the hardened layers. You see, wind and rain does not produce the tremendous weight and pressure to form solid rock layers.

Well here's where I get hard like a rock in my offering. If you believe the Book of Mormon to be the word of God, then you will find your answers to this dilemma as to why the difference between the Uintah's and the Rockies in God's words. Furthermore, if you can find an answer for this there, what other answers are there, the geologist are up in the night with their answers, but there is no mistake with God's answers. So again, to whom do you place your trust; God, or men of flesh?

If you really are placing your trust in God and what he gave you here's what it teaches you, and you and you.

Samuel the Lamanite, most likely one of the Ammonite Warriors. I figure he was about eighty-six years old when he gets on the walls of Zarahemla and says these words: (Now remember, the way you got these words, at least in the first place, was translated by God into English, given to Joseph Smith who reads them to his various scribes (3 or more). So don't argue with me, but God on this) Helaman 14:2-4 *And behold, he said unto them: Behold, I give unto you a sign; for five years more cometh, and behold, then cometh the Son of God to redeem all those who shall believe on his name. (This is supposed to be you, also.)* 3 *And behold, this I will give you for a sign at the time of his*

coming; for behold, there shall be great lights in heaven, insomuch that in the night before he cometh there shall be no darkness, insomuch that it shall appear unto man as if it was day. 4 Therefore, there shall be one day and a night and a day, as if it were one day and there were no night; and this shall be unto you for a sign; for ye shall know of the rising of the sun and also of its setting; therefore they shall know of a surety that there shall be two days and a night; nevertheless the night shall not be darkened; and it shall be the night before he is born. (Any questions as to what God has given you at this point? Put yourself in this situation as if you were there!) 5 And behold, there shall a new star arise, such an one as ye never have beheld; and it shall be the night before he is born. 6 And behold this is not all, there shall be many signs and wonders in heaven. 7 And it shall come to pass that ye shall all be amazed, and wonder, insomuch that ye shall fall to the earth. 8 And it shall come to pass that whosoever shall believe on the Son of God, (This is you too) the same shall have everlasting life. 9 And behold, thus hath the Lord commanded me, by his angel, that I should come and tell this thing unto you; (To you also) Yea, he hath commanded that I should prophesy these things unto you; Yea, he hath said unto me: Cry unto this people, repent and prepare the way of the Lord. (Now this is interesting, he is at the city of Zarahemla, their holy city, he is a Lamanite, the people who back in time was their enemies, and he is sharing the words God has given him, with those holier than thou Nephites, who don't have a clue, and they, like Lehi, attempt to kill him! Get the picture?) 10 And now, because I am a Lamanite, and have spoken unto you the words which the Lord hath commanded me, and because it was hard against you, ye are angry with me and do seek to destroy me, and have cast me out from among you. (See, you got to watch those Holy Cities, and as John says in Revelation which we are commanded to read, some hear a voice from heaven (Interesting, Not over a pulpit) and remove themselves from the cities, even that Babylon and its way of life before the coming cleansing.) 11 And ye shall hear my words, for, for this intent have I come up upon the walls of this city, that ye might hear and know of the judgments of God which do await you because of your iniquities, and also that ye might know the conditions of repentance; (Woo What a Guy! Wish we had some men today like him, but we don't need him, we have his message given by God in the days of the Gentiles.) 12 and also that ye might know of the coming of Jesus Christ, the Sun of God, (Just like today, its Jesus Christ who is to come in the beginning of the Millennium, where we are today, Interesting.), the Father of Heaven and Earth, the Creator of all things from the beginning; and that ye might know of the signs of his coming, to the intent that ye might believe on his name. (We've already been given our signs and warnings, even by Christ, in the Book of Mormon. Just in whom are you placing your trust?) 13 And if ye believe on his name ye will repent of all your sins, (What sins, smoking, drinking, not paying a full tithe or fast offering, not keeping your yards nice, not wearing a white shirt and tie to church, Is this the Iniquity he is referring too? Or is it something else, possibly treating his holy words as a thing of naught? Maybe) that thereby ye may have a remission of them through his merits. 14 And behold, again, another sign I give unto you, yea, a sign of his death. (Here goes, top this in your school geography classes where religion is forbidden to be taught) 15 For behold, he surely must die that salvation may come; yea, it behooveth him and becometh expedient that he dieth, to bring to pass the resurrection of the dead, that thereby men may be brought into the presence of the Lord. 16 Yea, behold, this death bringeth to pass the resurrection, and redeemeth all mankind from the first

death—that spiritual death; for all mankind, by the fall of Adam being cut off from the presence of the Lord, are considered as dead, both as to things temporal and to things spiritual. 17 But behold, the resurrection of Christ redeemeth mankind, yea, even all mankind, and bringeth them back into the presence of the Lord. 18 yea, and it bringeth to pass the condition of repentance, that whosoever repenteth the same is not hewn down and cast into the fire; but whosoever repenteth not is hewn down and cast into the fire; and there cometh upon them again a spiritual death, yea, a second death, for they are cut off again as to things pertaining to righteousness. 19 therefore repent ye, repent ye, lest by knowing these things and not doing them ye shall suffer yourselves to come under condemnation, and ye are brought down unto this second death. (Did you hear this! If you know these things God has given you) and do them not, you will suffer a second death—who are you listening too? How are you being taught to live by your leaders or teachers? Is it the same as God is teaching you in his Holy Word? Better be sure whose directions you’re placing your trust..) 20 But behold, as I said unto you concerning another sign, (Here we go! Hang on every word and you will understand the truth) of his death, behold, in the day that he shall suffer death the sun shall be darkened and refuse to give his light unto you; and also the moon and the stars; and there shall be no light upon the face of this land, even from the time that he shall suffer death, for the space of three days, to the time that he shall rise again from the dead. 21 Yea, at the time that he shall yield up the ghost there shall be thunderings and lightnings for the space of many hours, and the earth shall shake and tremble; and the rocks which are upon the face of this earth, which are both above the earth and beneath, which ye know at this time are solid, (This is about 6 B.C. and the rock above and beneath the earth has not as yet been disturbed since the creation) or the more part of it is one solid mass, shall be broken up; 22 Yea, they shall be rent in twain, and shall ever after be found in seams and in cracks, and in broken fragments upon the face of the whole earth, yea, both above the earth and beneath. 23 And behold, there shall be great tempests, and there shall be many mountains laid low, like unto a valley, and there shall be many places which are not called valleys which shall become mountains, and whose height is great. (Finish the rest in your book)

Now let’s get back to geography, according to what God has given us, before the crucifixion the rock was, for the more part, solid both above and beneath the earth.

This would mean, to me, that it had never been broken up prior to this time (34 A.D.). This contradicts the geologists of the world, who do you believe, them or God? This being the case, then those mountains we refer to as the Rocky Mountains, (it does not stop there), along with all other mountains on the earth which would include the first breaking up of the more solid rock of the earth, were in fact, disrupted at that same time.

The real interesting thing, once you have discovered that God knows what he is offering, is that why were they disrupted to such a degree in the first place? Christ explains this in 3rd Nephi the destruction has taken place and the pollution in the sky is beginning to dissipate when they hear a voice from heaven: 3 Nephi 9:13 *O all ye that are spared because ye were more righteous than they, will ye not now return unto me, and repent of your sins, and be converted, that I may heal you?*

You might say that I am reading between the lines here, but it does appear that if those to whom Christ is speaking to were saved because they were more righteous than those who perished, then the reason for the other to have been perished would be because

of their participation in sin. To take it a little further and again Christ says 3rd Nephi 10:12 *And it was the more righteous part of the people who were saved, ...*

Now another foresight by me, it would appear that the greatest destruction would be required and occur in the area where the greatest wickedness was, in order to destroy the more wicked. So I would think that you could look at where the greatest distortion to the layers of the earth has happened to determine where the more wicked could have been living.

If this could be the case, and we apply it to this immediate area, it would appear the greatest destruction was centered in the Rocky Mountains. Interesting Isaiah sees the gospel going forth from the tops of the everlasting mountains which has and is being done today. Could he have been seeing the Everlasting Mountains prior to their creation in 34 A.D.? Interesting, but now they exist, but why are the Uintah Mountains still in their original layers?

Now a little personal information here. I was born in Florida where it's nice and warm all year-round. We moved here when I was six, so as I was the oldest, the children could attend Utah schools in Mormon neighborhoods, as we were originally Utah pioneer Mormons. I have always had problems with colds, so my plan was to move south to where it was warmer as I got older. However, I have ended up in a colder place, Evanston, Wyoming. Strange, but interesting, I am nearer the Uintah Mountains. I even go there sometimes several times a week now. After moving here, I noticed driving back and forth that the layers of the earth seem to have gone through a less severe happening the closer I got to Evanston. As a matter of fact, as I just pass Evanston, strange, but I begin to see many, many flat topped mountains. Just how were they created, I wondered. I had remembered seeing these same flat topped mountains or hills when my dad had me stay the summer at my uncle Will's ranch in Cleveland, Utah, out by Price. I had the same feelings as I rode the horse to many of these flat topped hills. But now I am almost living in them. I even went so far as to take a carpenter's level out to the hills and checked them out, the close ones and those far away. They were all perfectly level, huh.

Now if the layers of Lake Bonneville were created by the movement of water, as I had been taught at BYU, then what created the perfectly flat top mountains? Could it have been water also? The I found out that there were no flat topped mountains in the basin of the old Lake Bonneville, Why?

Well I am going to tell you why, and I think I am the discover of this scenario, it never derived from any geologist or their publications, but it was derived as a result of reading my Book of Mormon. Here it is.

The flood took place at about 2348 B.C. and was used to destroy the more wicked, and did. As it receded, here is where the water could have created the flat topped hills, after all, most of them seem to be near 7000 feet in elevation and it's hard to get water that high. Next, why are there no flat topped mountains within the basin area of Lake Bonneville? That's easy, Lake Bonneville came about after the flood. Well how could that have happened? Again, using the Book of Mormon as my guide, it's easy. About 34 A.D. the mountains towering over the Salt Lake Valley were created according to God. After all, they are made up of solid rock having been broken up to form cracks and layers, and valleys and mountains of great height. Where else has this happened, if not with the Rocky Mountains.

Couple other points I might add here. The rangers at the Creators of the Moon, a massive volcanic lava flow of ancient times tell the tourists that it took place about 2000 years ago. Interesting, the crucifixion was about 2000 years ago. Another, not to long ago scientist wondered why the state of Nebraska was covered with volcanic ash and yet there has been no volcano's in that state. The tested the chemical composition of the ash to determine where it came from. Interesting, it came from Yellowstone. It was determined that Yellowstone lake was the remains of a Supper Volcano. That the ash filled the air and move eastward around the world dropping its ash all over world much less Nebraska.

Now I would like you to re-thing Mt. St. Helen's, this happened in your lifetime so you can better relate to it. Just a small part of the top of only one mountain blew its top. The debris in the air darkened the skies as it moved eastward around the world. It even had an effect on the weather worldwide.

Now lets put our trust in God instead of man. 3rd Nephi read starting at chapter 8, but we will skip to verse 5 And it came to pass in the thirty and fourth year, in the first month, and the fourth day (January 4, 34 A.D. on our calendar), there arose a great storm, such an one as never had been known in all the land.

Now these people were down wind of what was taking place, most likely a polar shift is beginning. 6 And there was also a great and terrible tempest; and there was terrible thunder, insomuch that it did shake the whole earth as it was about to divide asunder. You bet, the earth up wind had divided, valleys, and mountains created, fractures in the earth especially in the Idaho area opened up volcanic actions with lava spewing out, massive amounts of rock thrown into the air, with unbelievable amounts of air pollutions forming. Most likely with the breaking up of the earth in the former Nephite lands, now inhabited by wicked Lamanites, the opening of the Grand Canyon occurred.

Now it take a little time for this happening to move across about three thousand miles to the east, however, the shaking of the earth must have happened more rapidly. Soon however the whole face of the land eastward, and most likely worldwide was blackened such that no fires could be lit. The effects happen world wide with the darkness and even the opening of the earth took place in Jerusalem at Christ's death.

Now you see, the more elect of the Mormon Church place the Book of Mormon lands on the east coast of southern Mexico. It that had truly been the place, the volcanic ash would have gone out to sea, and most likely the sun may have shown the next day. Plus west of that area there are no volcano's, however, the mountains are a part of what Isaiah say, as an extension of the Rockies from Alaska to the tip of South America.

As the skies blackened, and the massive flow of hot lava flowed over the Idaho, Utah and part of Wyoming area, the massive heat rose into the skies along with the pollutants. Much like a small forest fire, soon the cooler air rushes in at the bottom of the rising heat drawing in rain clouds to put out the fire. Likewise, many times greater then any forest fire, this lava did the same. Soon massive moisture came from the skies putting out the fire and cooling the lava, but at the same time because of the blackness of the skies blocking the effects of the sun, the water turns to ice to form glaciers.

Much of the northwest then is covered with a massive ice sheet to soon begin to melt and break up as the sun finally comes out. The sheets of ice rapidly melt and break up with the melted water seeking its lowest point and mixing with the dirt and mud below

forming the lubricant to allow the massive broken ice to move southward towards the equator.

I can look outside my window to see the effects of a massive sheet of ice which formed the valley behind and under my home. The small hills pushed up loaded with round rock prove this theory as the ice sheet bounced off the more solid portions heading toward and to form what we call Bear Lake now.

The same thing happened as ice sheets and water melted and moved down some of the canyons into the newly formed basin we call the Salt Lake Valley crated by the sediment of the former Lake Bonneville.

The rising of the mountains, the lava, topped off with the massive ice sheets and their movements, along with the massive flows of water and the rising of Lake Bonneville completely, or at least almost completely destroyed every sign of the former inhabitation know as the Lamanites. However, a few who either survived or migrated from the north in time took up residence around the newly formed Lake Bonneville, as their remains can be still found there at the high water marks.

So why are there no flat topped hills within the Lake Bonneville Basin? You're right, they were destroyed with the happenings at 34 A.D. as given us by God. And what happened to Lake Bonneville? Don't look for men of flesh to teach you this, as they are still in the dark on this subject. Some even are arguing that there never was a flood. The unmistakable answer can be read in the geography. Plus, how come there is only two water marks?

Lake Bonneville rapidly came into existence and was rapidly emptied. It reached the high water mark and the softer earth broke way to the northwest. The water dropped to the second high watermark rested a short time, when a second break occurred in as the waters soaked through to allow the major emptying of the lake. This is easily determined by realizing that for the water to even reach the first and second watermarks, the land configuration had to have been like a large bowl. Today part of the bowl is missing. Interesting, the therefore the bowl could never be filled again. But were is the break in the bowl, and where did the water go?

The break or the part of the bowl that is missing is to the south, between the higher mountains of southern California and eastward into Texas. The water rapidly emptied moving south mostly between the mountains of Baja California and the mountains of Mainland Mexico to form the present Sea of Cortez. Some water however, moved across Mexico eastward emptying into the Gulf of Mexico. Looking at a contour map any six year old can identify this happening but why not our professors of flesh.

To further add to my story and theory here is a little experience with my daughter Erika and I.

Two years ago my daughter Erika and I went down the Green River from Fontenelle Dam towards Green River Wyoming. It was late in the fall, but the sun was shining and we were wearing shorts and sandals, and wouldn't you know it, we hit a ferrous snow storm. Well needless to say, I feel I almost had the opportunity to meet my maker, but luck with us and we made it with a little help from two of the huge Trona Plants, near by. They sent a four-wheel drive to get us and we ended up at the plants while my wife came to retrieve us. These plants are huge, hiring some 800 people in each. I asked a lot of questions and got a lot of answers. They mine down 1600 feet to a layer of soda Ashe. Then they mine thirteen miles in each direction from each plant

taking out this soda Ashe. Now it didn't hit me for a while, but hears what I learned. If these plants can mine in thirteen miles in all directions from each plant, and there are many plants, the layers of the ground are still in tact. Very interesting!

This means, that great changes took place in the Salt Lake Valley, with little change in Evanston, and no underground change just east of Evanston. Just how far does the layers go eastward without changes? Was another question.

Well a few years ago Thinn, my wife and I were back east selling my Food PANtries in some Preparedness Shows. While in Tennessee on a freeway, sometimes the freeway would dip into the earth at the underpasses. While going through the areas cut in the layers of the earth, I noticed that when they cut down through the layers, the layers were still in tact. For the more part, unbroken. Then somewhere in here, I learned that the Great Lakes, it is said, were formed by massive pieces of ice having been broken off the main ice sheet from the north and had scooped out the Great lakes. But then what happened with the Ice from there? Looking at my original Book of Mormon geography map I got at the Church Distribution Center, I could see that those ice pieces, having scooped out the areas of the Great Lakes must have pushed that earth in front of them as they melted and migrated southward towards the equator to form the Mississippi valley delta. In the process I could see from the contour map, that earth squished eastward to form the Appalachian Mountains. Interesting, these mountains had not been produced by the breaking up of the more part of the rock both above and beneath the earth at the time of the crucifixion. But possibly by the glaciers created at that time, as there were glaciers created as the massive pollution circled the earth, as did the smaller Mt. Helens did as it circled the earth or at an earlier glacial period of time, possibly after the flood. I haven't thought this one out as yet.

The interesting thing is, the more I seem to use the Book of Mormon as my starting point for truth, the more the other pieces of the puzzle seem to come together.

Another thing which might be of interest to some. Christ in 3rd Nephi also mentions that because of wickedness, again evidently, those same mountains which were raised up, will be again lowered! I would imagine for the self-same reason, wickedness. Why on earth would God allow a similar happening which created those Rocky Mountains, to again happen? And why would anyone who, using the Book of Mormon, which is true and the word of God, want to live in and around those mountains which for some reason, will again be lowered according to Christ? Not me!

Again interesting, many people ask me where a safe place to live is? Well, funny thing, I have discovered that in the Apocrypha telling of the creation of the world, that Adam is told of a Sacred Mountain in a place called Paradise, which is westward in the Land Eden, which according to the scriptures is in fact "The Promised Land", or the land of liberty unto the Gentiles of our day. And within this Sacred Mountain, there is a Sacred Cave. I guess much like the caves of Hebron where the righteous in that part of the land were entombed. God instructs Adam of the embalming process and says that he is to have his family embalm him and place his body in this Sacred Cave. To be there until the end of time when he and the others place there are to be resurrected. I have found that the Sacred Mountain/s are the Uintah Mountains, the one which have not been disrupted. And Adam is to be safe there until Christ comes. Woo I am living next to a Sacred Mountain, which has not been disturbed, and wont be disturbed until Christ comes, where better to live? And I have learned this by reading, pondering, doing a little

geographical and archeological work on my part, along with a lot of prayer, and refusing to rely on men of flesh who wish determine my directions in life.
