### **#75 A Whole New World of Discovery (Awakening) Trusting in God's Words (ONLY).**

Unlike Adam who was created as an adult and then taught or trained by God himself as Adam walked and talked with God, we on the other hand have been raised as an infant from birth with the necessity of placing our trust or trained to trust in flesh.

In our dispensation as the Gentiles, we have been given a more pure form of God's Holy Word, we call it the Book of Mormon. As we follow the directions God then gives us, that of praying to God to determine the truthfulness of these words, most of us are given our first direct revelation from God our Creator as the words of this abridge word of his words are true, Moroni 10:4 *And when ye shall receive these things, I would exhort you that ye would ask God, the Eternal Father, in the name of Christ, if these things are not true; and if ye shall ask with a sincere heart, with real intent, having faith in Christ, he will manifest the truth of it unto you, by the power of the Holy Ghost.*

God accomplishes this by way of his Holy Ghost. We are then taught by God through direct personal revelation and not by and through men of flesh, that by this example we may know the truth of all things, Moroni 10:5 *And by the power of the Holy Ghost ye may know the truth of **all things**.* What more does a person need?

In addition and to fortify this very exclusive righteous process and in several places in what he has given us, God warns us that if we place trust in any personage or man of flesh, we are CURSED, 2 Nephi 28:31 *Cursed is he that putteth his trust in man, or maketh flesh his arm, or shall hearken unto the precepts of men, save their precepts shall be given by the power of the Holy Ghost.* Thus it might be wise to evaluate ourselves to see if we are relying on or placing our trust in men above and between ourselves and our God. Furthermore, the only mention by God in the Book of Mormon of prophets in the days of the Gentiles is when God warns us to beware of FALSE PROPHETS in our day, 3 Nephi 14:15 *Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing (Wool Suits?), but inwardly they are ravening wolves.* Could these be men of flesh who allow themselves to be placed above us as a light unto the world, 2 Nephi 26:29 *He (God) commandeth that there shall be no priestcrafts; for, behold, priestcrafts are that men preach and set themselves up for a light unto the world, that they may get gain and praise of the world; but they seek not the welfare of Zion (Real Zion is God's way of life).* Could we be those who God warns as he says unto us 2 Nephi 28:26 *Yea, wo be unto him that hearkeneth unto the precepts of men, and denieth the power of God, and the gifts of the Holy Ghost.*

Is the Book of Mormon actually the Marvelous Work referred to in 2 Nephi 29 as he teaches us, *But behold, there shall be many--(could this be us?) at that day when I shall proceed to do a marvelous work among them, that I may remember my covenants which I have made unto the children of men, that I may set my hand again the second time to recover my people, which are of the house of Israel.* Are we those children of men, as

mentioned above? And are we from Israel, the pure blood of Adam not Cain? And in verse 2, *that I would remember your seed; and that the words of your seed* (Lehi/Nephi's seed or the Book of Mormon) *should proceed forth out of my mouth* (given translated by Christ and given through a top hat to Joseph Smith as the Book of Mormon we are reading from) *unto your seed* (Through the Gentiles of our day to their seed) *and my words* (The Book of Mormon) *will hiss forth unto the ends of the earth* (by the missionaries), *for a standard* (God's words to live by, not man's words) *unto my people* (Those who do not treat his words as a thing of naught, 2 Nephi 33:2 *But behold, there are many that harden their hearts against the Holy Spirit, that it hath no place in them; wherefore, they cast many things away which are written and esteem them as things of naught.*), *which are of the house of Israel;*

You need to keep in mind what God gave us through Moroni, as Moroni sees our very day and says: Mormon 8:33 *O ye wicked and perversed and stiffnecked people, why have ye built up churches unto yourselves to get gain?* (The Mormon church, already in the late 70's had become the second largest builder in the world, second to the United States Government. I was assisting in building these churches) *Why have ye TRANSFIGURED the holy word of God, that ye might bring damnation upon your soles?* My understanding of Transfiguring is to change either the words themselves or the precepts of those words. Next Moroni says: Mormon 8:38 *O ye pollutions, ye hypocrites, ye TEACHERS, who sell yourselves for that which will canker, why have ye POLLUTED THE HOLY CHURCH OF GOD?* If the LDS Church is the only true church of God on the earth, then Moroni must see its pollution by its Teachers. Primarily no one else but those of the LDS Church are reading these Holy Words of God.

According to the word given us by God, we must learn to separate ourselves from this process and place our complete trust in God, if we do not we are then cursed. Some of the cursing's as pointed out by God are: By placing something or someone between our God and ourselves is referred to as Idolatry. Worse than this, we are taught by Gods words that if we do not follow what he teaches in his words we are treating his words as a thing of naught and stand accused, Ether 4:8 *And he that will contend against the word of the Lord, let him be accused; and he that shall deny these things, let him be accursed; for unto them will I show no greater things, saith Jesus Christ; for I am he who speaketh.* and in doing so we are not trusting in him (God) and the process by which the Book of Mormon was confirmed to be truth by direct revelation from our God to ourselves through the Holy Ghost, the same process by which we are to gain the truth of all things; thus by not trusting in this process and placing trust in men of flesh we are denying the Holy Ghost, the gravest sin of all.

It is proven to change a nation or people it can be done by establishing the way our children think throughout their youth. Consequently, we have learned to place trust in flesh more than placing our pure trust in God our creator.

So where should we go from here?  
We must repent?  
But what do we repent of?

It appears we must repent of the things we are doing that are not taught by the Holy Word of God, the precepts we are not instructed to live.

We must either trust in Men of Flesh who have taken upon themselves the power of God to transfigure God's Holy words and precepts, as my brother told me, "We don't even need the Book of Mormon, we have a Prophet", or we must revert to just living what God has given us in his Holy Word.

If we choose to revert to just what God has taught us, then we would be repenting of our errors in trusting in men of flesh, those we have allowed to be placed above us in righteousness.

Thus we then can stand approved at judgment day, according to what Christ teaches, as we meet Christ and Moroni who will witness that he did, in fact, give us God's Holy Word, by which we are to be judged at judgment day according to Christ.
